- <u>Legislation:</u> Jack provided updates on two bills that will be introduced during the upcoming North Dakota Legislative Session. The bills are as follows:
 - Advanced Imaging: prosed legislation has been drafted and presented to the sponsor. Senate bill will be introduced in early days of the legislative session.
 - Informed Consent; proposed legislation has been drafted and presented to sponsor. Senate bill will be introduced in early part of session. Will need Physical Therapist to testify.
- <u>FSBPT Annual Meeting:</u> Marcus and Steve shared the main topics at this year's
 FSBPT annual meeting. Topics included: boundary issues, use of AI, state
 complaint processes, suspension of license when under investigation and dry
 needling competency.
- <u>Dry Needling Verification</u>: Scott provided an update on dry needling verification in other states. There are other states that request licensees to disclose if they are certified in dry needling. Variety in states which require an upload of verification vs. the licensee simply stating whether or not they are certified.
